

Pharmacy Technician

Helps prepare students to pass the Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPhT)* exam.



This six-month long course prepares students to take the third-party certification exam to become a Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPhT)*.

Through direct instruction, interactive tasks, and practice assignments, students learn the basics of pharmacy assisting, including pharmacy calculations and measurements, pharmacy law, pharmacology, medical terminology and abbreviations, and medicinal drugs. Students also learn sterile techniques, USP 795 and 797 standards, maintenance of inventory, patient record systems, data processing automation in the pharmacy, and employability skills. Successful completion of the course prepares students for the Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPhT)* exam.
